



Raymond Shute Memorial Award

In honor of Raymond Shute, the Society of Plastics Engineers' Thermoplastic Materials & Foams Division (SPE TPM&F) is offering travel awards for students presenting a research paper or poster at a TPM&F-sponsored conference (SPE FOAMS, International Polyolefins Conference, or SPE ANTEC).

Each travel award will provide up to \$750 USD to reimburse student travel expenses. Winners will be selected based on academic achievements, extracurricular activities, career interest in TPM&F, and potential to contribute to the Plastics Engineering field.

The application deadline is February 28, 2019.

Criteria & Rules

1. Applicant must be a full-time student.
2. Applicant must be a SPE TPM&F student member.
3. Applicants must create a poster or paper presentation in one of the upcoming TPM&F sponsored Conferences in 2019.
4. Applicant must be in good academic standing (GPA > 3.0 or equivalent).
5. The Travel Award is a **reimbursement only** award with a maximum reimbursement level of \$750 USD. The award winner will pay for the travel expenses first and will be reimbursed afterward. Note that eligible expenses include hotel, transportation, meals, visa, and/or poster printing cost. Receipt copies are required for reimbursement, so please remember to keep all the receipts for the expenses. The Travel Award will be withdrawn if an awardee does not attend or present at one of the conferences listed above.
